2010 SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS

SUMMARY:

The PAPHCC Scholarship Committee has a total of three (3) scholarships in June 2010 that may be awarded:

Ralph Hay Scholarship - \$1,000, Joe White Scholarship - \$1,000 and Pinellas Association PHCC Scholarship - \$500.

The PAPHCC scholarships are designed to provide partial funding to recent high school graduates or other individuals to advance their education at a technical trade school or two- or four-year nationally accredited college or university. Scholarship funds will be distributed prior to the beginning of the academic year and can *only* be used for tuition, books, and tools.

To apply for these annual scholarships, applicants must **complete the required forms and provide all requested materials** to the PAPHCC Scholarship Committee no later than the specified deadline.

REQUIREMENTS:

A PAPHCC **contractor member must sponsor** the scholarship applicant. The first consideration for applicants is given to PAPHCC contractor member employees or families. PAPHCC sponsoring members must be a Contractor Member in good standing for at least two (2) years.

First time scholarship applicants must have a **high school diploma** or an equivalent **GED** or be **graduating** from high school in 2010. A **grade point average (GPA) of at least 2.6** is required if a high school graduate or enrolled currently in a post secondary program. All **high school seniors** applying must have a documented overall 2.6 academic GPA **upon graduating high school**. Current GPA documentation **must** be attached to the scholarship application. Applicants may formally apply when they are candidates for acceptance at a technical trade school or a two- or four-year nationally accredited college or university.

Full time students in the reapplication process **must reapply yearly** and be enrolled full-time in classes during the reapplication procedure.

All applicants must complete the required paperwork and submit it to the PAPHCC Scholarship Committee. Applicants who receive these scholarships are required to attend the meeting at which their scholarship certificate will be presented. Scholarship recipients are required to send **grade reports** to the PAPHCC Scholarship Committee **each semester** covered by the scholarship documenting their academic progress.

The application must be completed and submitted by the applicant. To be submitted with the application form are the following letters of recommendation: one from a teacher, school administrator, or immediate supervisor; one from a person not related to the applicant; and one from the company sponsor. Each letter must state why the individual should be considered as a candidate for the PAPHCC scholarship program. The applicant is also required to write a letter with a minimum of 250 words and a maximum of 500 words describing why he/she should be considered as a recipient of the PAPHCC scholarship. All decisions by the Scholarship Committee are final upon approval by the Board of Directors of PAPHCC.

IMPORTANT DATES:

The 2010 schedule for review and distribution is as follows:

Scholarship applications are **available** beginning **January 13, 2010**.

All applications are **due** to the Scholarship Committee **Friday, April 2, 2010**.

All applications are **reviewed** and selected by the Scholarship Committee in **May 2010**.

Board review and approval is at the Board meeting in **May 2010**.

Scholarship awards are **announced** at the **June 2010** General Membership meeting.
